

FUEL ASSISTANCE

2010-2011

Applications for year 2010-2011 heating season are now available at the Ludlow Senior Center. **Applications are taken on Mondays and Wednesdays, BY APPOINTMENT ONLY for those over 60 years of age and living in Ludlow.**

The documentation you need for Fuel Assistance this year has changed. You will need to bring the following information in order to fill out your application completely:

-Proof of Fixed Income: If you have Social Security benefits, you will need a copy of one of the following documents: A copy of your benefits letter, a recent (within 30 days) bank statement, copy of a recent check, or if direct deposit, a letter from your bank stating what the direct deposit amount is. For all other income (pension, interest, dividends) you must have a copy of your award letter in addition to one of the following: a current (within 30 days) bank statement, copy of check or a letter from the bank.

-Unemployment – copies of stubs from the last 4 consecutive pay periods.

-Heating, Electric & Telephone Bills- the complete bill with the account numbers.

-2010/2011 Sewer/Water bill or Tax bill or House insurance bill

-If renting – landlord information: name, address and telephone number.

-If working – 4 consecutive pay stubs prior to your application date.

You may also apply for assistance if your heat is included in your rent.

Fuel assistance starts November 1, 2010 and you can apply through April 29, 2011. For more information or to make an appointment, call 583-3564.

Unfortunately, appointments are only being accepted for those over 60 years of age at this time.
