TRANSFER STATION AND COMPOST FACILITY

EFFECTIVE July 1, 2018

HOURS OF OPERATION

WEDNESDAY thru SATURDAY

8:00 AM – 3:00 PM (Gates close at 2:50 pm)

Permits are available at the DPW office to Ludlow residents for vehicles registered to a Ludlow address, in the amount of **\$15.00 each, residents age 62 & over are free**, and are required for entry to the Transfer Station and Compost Facility. Vehicle registration must be presented to obtain permit. Office hours are Monday–Friday 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Replacement permits (within the same year) will be issued upon receipt of original permit. Permits are valid January 1, 2018 - December 31, 2018. Exceptions may be granted based on proof of Ludlow home ownership.

No commercial vehicle or vehicle larger than a pick up truck will be allowed access to the Transfer Station or Compost Facility.

Transfer Station

Residents with a permit may dispose of the following:

- Residential household trash (**MUST be in Town of Ludlow purple trash bags**)
- Auto and truck batteries
- Recyclable Materials: glass, metal, steel, newspaper, cans
- Cardboard cut to 2 X 2 size and single polymer plastic containers
- Fluorescent tubes, mercury bearing devices
- Waste oil
- Propane Tanks

Disposal Fee – must be purchased at the DPW Office:

*Checks will be accepted at the Transfer Station on **Saturdays** only*

The following items are **NOT ACCEPTED** at the Transfer Station:

- Lead paint
- Gasoline
- Ceramic toilet, sink, tub, etc.
- Truck tires
- Hazardous waste as defined by DEP (such as paint thinner, turpentine, solvents, lawn chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, pool chemicals, etc.)
- Construction debris (wood, drywall, cabinets, fencing, decking, etc.)

Compost Facility

- Branches, grass, leaves

Ludlow residents are encouraged to take full advantage of town-wide curbside trash and recyclable collection and disposal.
