Municipal Officials – I wanted to make you aware of upcoming Eversource maintenance work that will be occurring in your Municipality along the rights -of-way.

Transmission Maintenance is going to be inspecting and repainting some existing transmission structures and maintaining access roads within the rights-of-way in many Western MA locations.

- Work is scheduled to begin this fall and continue through the winter;
- Work hours are Monday – Saturday, 7 am to 7 pm;
- This work will occur in phases and will not be continuous in any one area.

The nearby property owners are being provided with a 1-800 number and an email address if they would like additional information. A copy of the Start of Work letter is attached for your records.

- Ludlow - this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Center St, Saw Mill Rd, Miller St, Carmelina Circle, Longrider Lane, East St, Chapin St.
- Wilbraham - this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Boston Rd, Manchonis Rd, Springfield St, Tinkham Rd, Soule Rd, Stoney Hill Rd.
- East Longmeadow - this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Denslow Rd, Shaker Rd, Prospect, South Brook Rd, Country Club Drive, Somers Rd, Meadowbrook Rd
- Longmeadow - this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Williams St, Wolfswamp Rd
- Hampden - this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Allen St, East Longmeadow Rd, and Mill Rd.
- Granby – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Carver St, Rte 202/State St, Fred Ruel Rd, Bachelor St, and Stebbins St
- Belchertown – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Carver St, Bachelor St, George Hannum St, Stebbins St, Bay Rd, Orchard Rd, Nowworruck Rail Trail, Warren Wright Rd, North St, Old Amherst Rd, and Rte 9/Federal St

- Amherst – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Bay Rd, Hulst Rd, Fales Rd, and Pratt Corner Rd
- Pelham – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Amherst Rd, and North Valley Rd
- Shutesbury – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Sand Hill Rd
- Leverett – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Old January Hills Rd, Shutesbury Rd, Rattlesnake Gutter Rd, North Leverett Rd
- Montague – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Chestnut Hill Loop, East Chestnut Hill Rd, Cross Rd, Wendell Rd, Davis Rd, Mormon Hollow Rd
- Erving – this work will take place in the rights-of-way off of Rte 2/Mohawk Trail, Old State Rd
- Westfield – this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Northwest Rd, Western Ave, Gladwin Dr, Llewlyn Drive, Russell Rd, Pochassic Rd, Furrowtown Rd, Jeremy Circle, Prospect St
- Blandford – this work will take place along the right of way near the area of North Blandford Rd, Otis State Rd, Herrick Rd, South St, Cobble Mountain Rd, Hayden Rd
- Russell – this work will take place along the right of way near the area of South Quarter Rd
- Granville – this work will take place along the right of way near the area of Wildcat Rd, Old Westfield Rd, Main Rd, Sodom St
- Southwick – this work will take place along the right of way near the area of S Loomis St, Vining Hill Rd, Lincoln Rd, Mort Vining Hill Rd

As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers and communities, we'll be mowing access as necessary, inspecting and repainting existing transmission structures multiple areas in Western MA. Maintaining the infrastructure that supports electric lines is one of the many ways Eversource ensures the safe, secure transmission of electricity throughout the region.

Reliability Improvements in Your Neighborhood

We are always working to serve you better and will be working in your area within the next couple of weeks. This maintenance work is taking place on the right of way that is on or near your property. You may have already received prior notification of the replacement of some structures, installation of new communication wire or vegetation maintenance activities in these same areas that is already in progress.

What You Can Expect

First, we want you to know this work will not interrupt electric service to your property, and that people working on the project carry proper identification at all times. Crews from Supreme Industries, JHD, Inc. and Osmose will be working for Eversource to conduct the mowing, inspect existing transmission structures, and repainting on the rights of way located on or near your property. In some instances, the crews may hand excavate around the base of the structure. The excavated area will be filled in before moving on to the next structure.

Crews will be walking or riding in ATVs, using mowing equipment and bucket trucks within the rights of way.

Work hours will be Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Please keep in mind that the schedule may change due to weather and other unexpected circumstances.
