Mr. Rosenblum **moved** to nominate Richard Moskal as chairman of the Cable Committee. Second by Ms. Villano. Motion passed 5-0.

Ms. Villano **moved** to nominated Mr. Assaf as vice chairman of the Cable Committee. Second by Mr. Ghazil. Motion passed 5-0.

Attorney Bill August and the committee discussed the draft of the license proposal with Charter. Mr. August wanted to remove an "early termination" clause and incorporate a "reasonable level playing field" clause. The draft document provides for a 4.5% franchise fee.

Mr. Hill shared some minor changes with Mr. August.

The committee would like to request that Charter keeps the Ludlow storefront open.


Mr. Ghazil **moved** to send the working draft to Charter. Second by Mr. Assaf. Motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Hill told the committee he is looking to install a video recording and broadcasting system in the high school auditorium. He has budgeted \$150,000 for this project. Ms. Villano asked if there has been a conversation with the high school about this yet. Mr. Hill said he has discussed this with the principal. Ms. Villano asked how this will affect the money that needs to be invested in the new school administration building. She also asked if equipment should also be installed in the new school and/or the new senior center. Mr. Hill said there is money in the budget for the equipment at the new school administration building. He said there is money in the budget if it's decided to add equipment to the new school or the senior center.


Mr. Assaf **moved** to approve the purchase of the equipment up to \$150,000. Second by Mr. Ghazil. Motioned passed 5-0.
